Content of Presentation

The goal of this presentation is to give participants a thorough working understanding of the ASTM F1292-13* standard for Impact Attenuation of Surface Systems Under and Around Playground Equipment. Key concepts include terminology, compliance analysis, initial and future performance criteria, and types of injuries, minimum and stringent specifier requisites, post-installation testing and more.

Who Should Attend

This presentation is for seasoned park professionals that want a refresher course as well as new park professionals whose job description requires a working knowledge of the ASTM F1292.

*The ASTM Standard Specification for Impact Attenuation of Surface Systems Under and Around Playground Equipment is known as the ASTM F1292. This standard accounts for both the deceleration of the head during impact and the length of time the head takes to stop moving. The test simulates the impact of a child's head hitting the surface from various heights of the playground equipment.
